Terms of Reference for the RAIC Festival Renewal Committee

(September 2015)

1. Name: RAIC Festival Renewal Committee

2. Purpose

2.1 The purpose of the Festival Renewal Committee is to develop a new vision for the annual RAIC Festival, with a greater focus on public engagement.

3. Membership

- 3.1 Members of the Festival Renewal Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Directors. The Festival Renewal Committee shall be comprised of up to five members.
- 3.2 The Chair of the Committee shall be elected by the members of the Committee. The Board of Directors shall ratify the selection of the chairperson.
- 3.3 The terms of appointment shall be for three years. Effort shall be made to stagger all appointments to provide overlap and continuity.

4. Duties

- 4.1 The Festival Renewal Committee shall prepare alternative visions for the Festival, for review and approval of the Board of Directors.
- 4.2 The Festival Renewal Committee shall research similar events held by allied organizations.
- 4.3 The Festival Renewal Committee shall explore possible partnerships with other events and organizations, particularly those with an existing audience.

- 5.1 Program resources (budget, staff time, etc.) are approved by the Board of Directors.
- 5.2 The administrative expenses of the Festival Renewal Committee shall be remunerated at cost.
