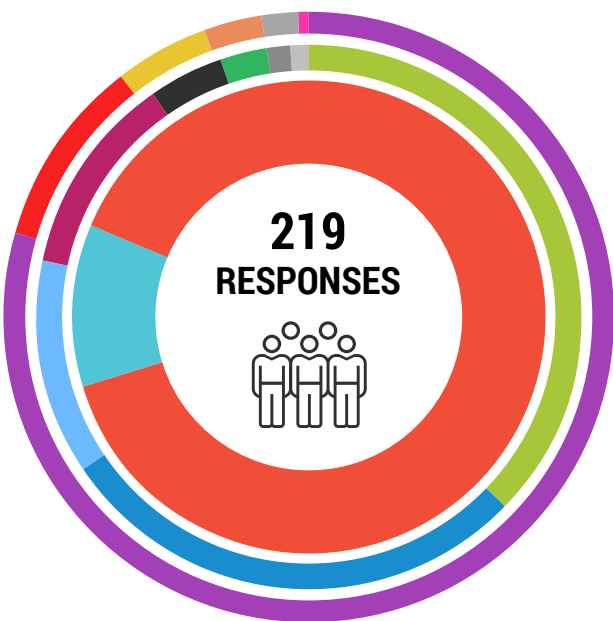
COVID-19 PULSE SURVEY #4 – SUMMARY

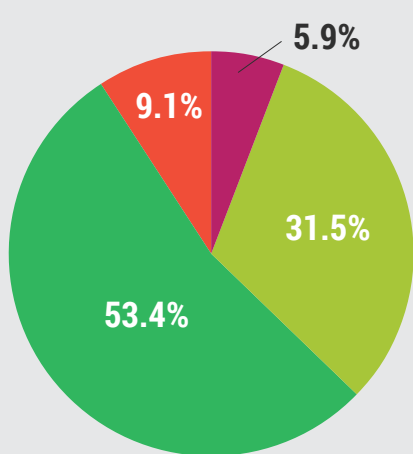
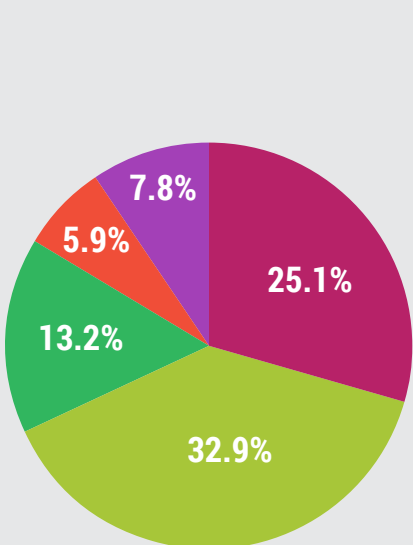
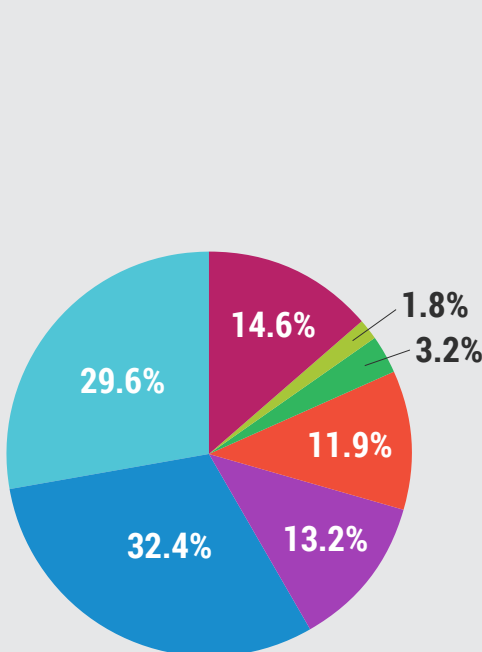

- Unemployed 0.9%



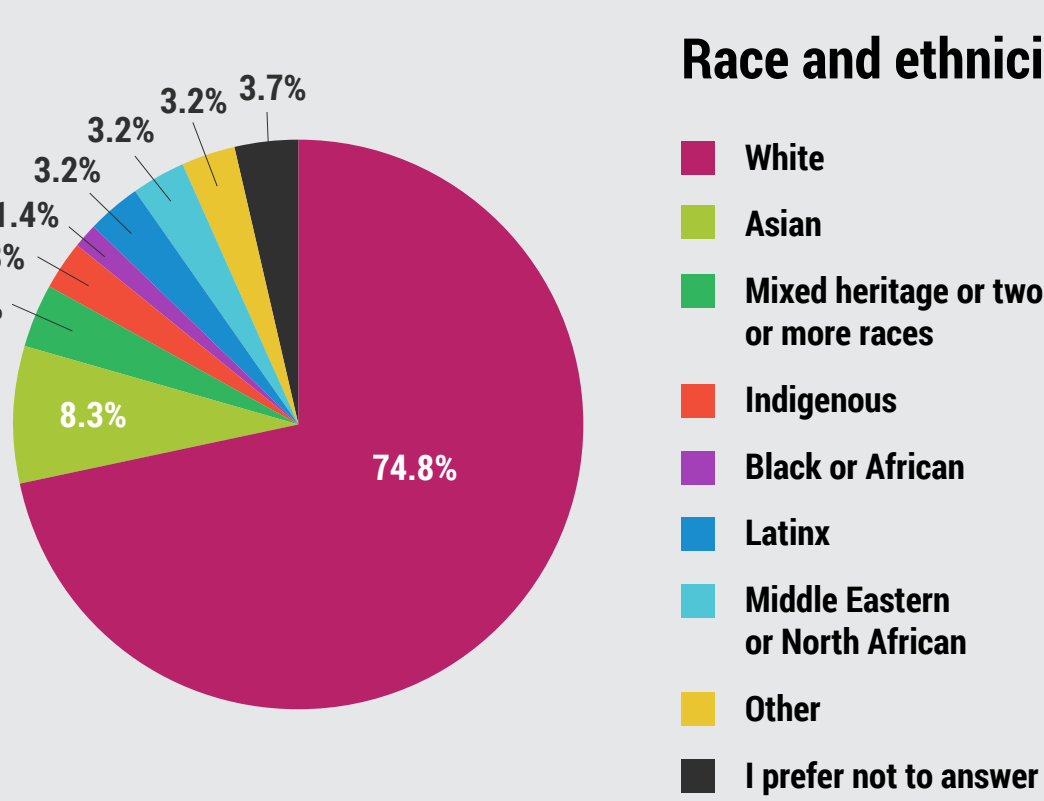
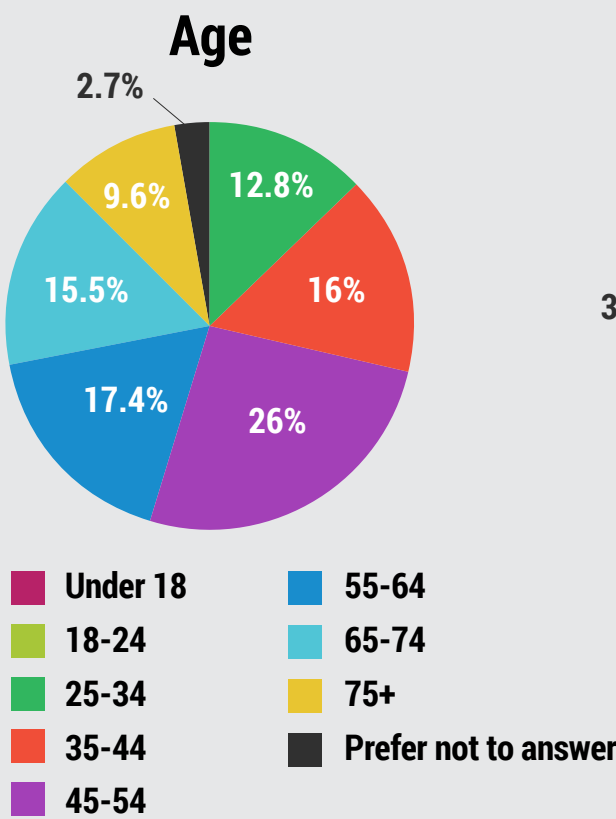
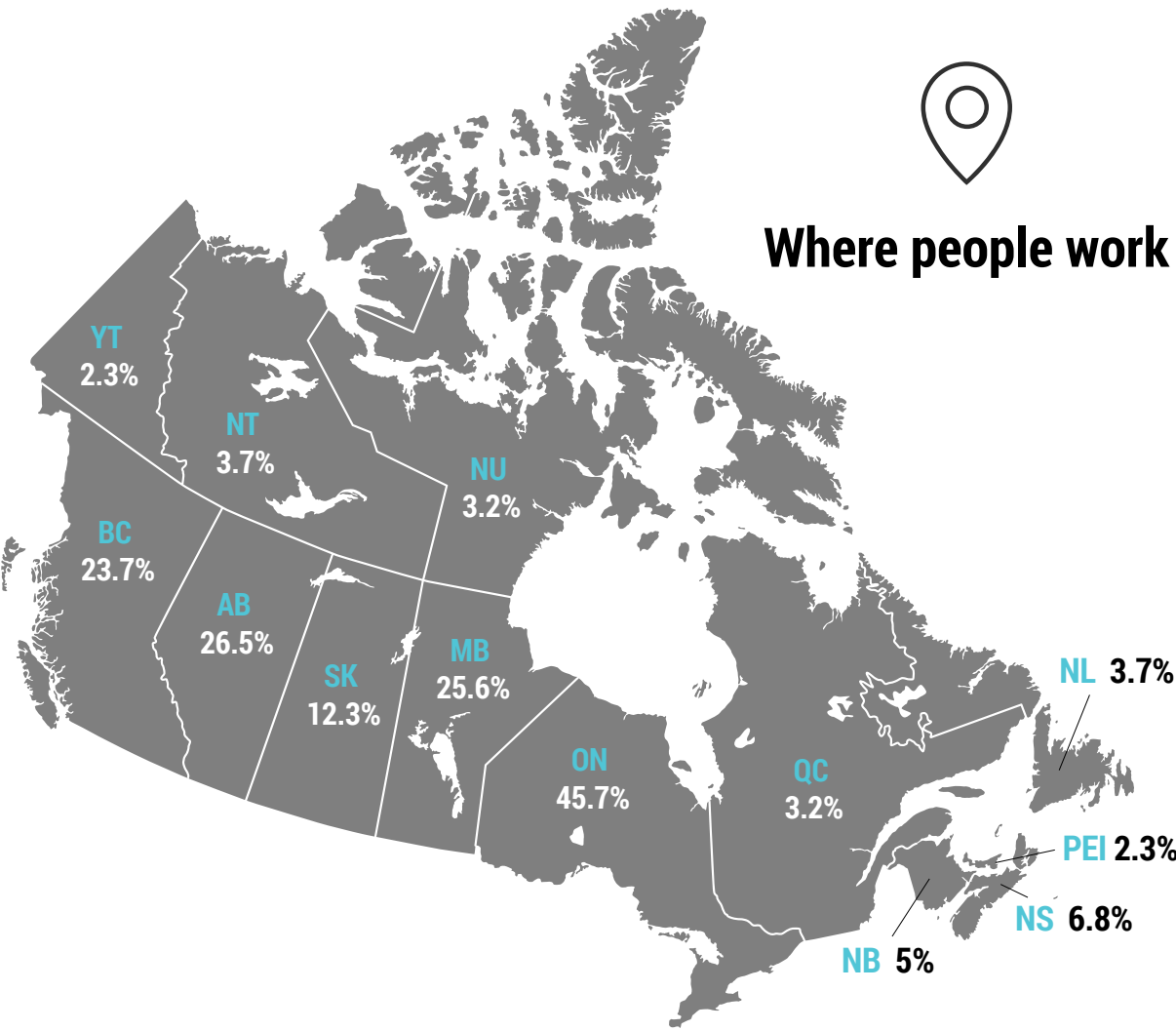
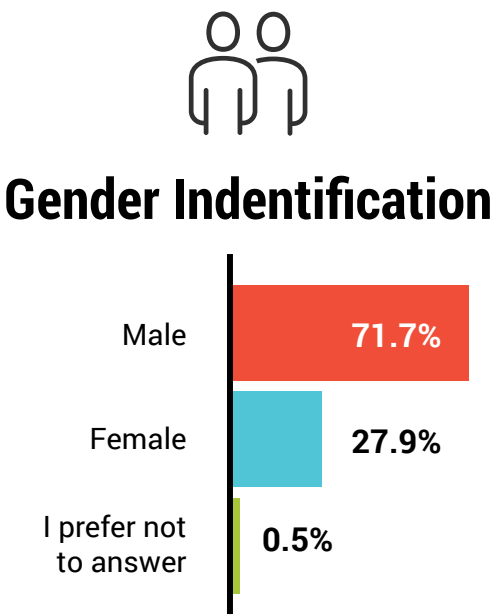
PANDEMIC AND PRACTICE

- 26.1% have reduced staff work hours
- 16.4% continue to have reduced work hours
- 30.4% have had to lay off staff
- 35.2% continue to experience loss of revenue
- 27.4% individuals have had their income reduced
- 23.7% not back to "business as usual" service delivery
- 36.5% experiencing supply chain issues
- 55.7% construction projects experiencing material supply delays
- 51.1% experiencing delayed tendering and construction
- 44.7% have suspended projects in design and construction documents phases
- 50.7% perceive fewer project opportunities
